ADDITIONAL GUIDELIENS FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE OCTOBER 2014 WACS EXAMINATIONS

The President-in-Council has approved the following modifications to the conduct of October 2014 WACS Examinations in all Centres.

WRITTEN PAPERS

- There shall be Infrared Laser Thermometer screening for Candidates, Staff and Examiners prior to admission into Examination Hall
- Anybody with a recorded temperature of >37.5 degree Celsius will be referred for further evaluation.
- Hand hygiene involving the use of Hand sanitizers by all before entrance into the Examination Hall.
- All Candidates, staff and Examiners are to arrive by **7.30 a.m.** for ALL **WRITTEN PAPERS**.

CLINICAL EXAMINATIONS

- Infrared Laser thermometer screening for Patients, Candidates, Staff and Examiners
- Hand hygiene involving the use of Hand sanitizers.
- The use of Hand Gloves

ORAL EXAMINATIONS

- Infrared Laser thermometer screening for Patients, Candidates, Staff and Examiners
- Hand Sanitizers
- Seating arrangement with at least 1 meter separation between Examiners and Candidate.
